- Tuition and Fee charges are based on how many CU's you take per semester. For a full list of tuition and fees please visit our [website](#).
- Your total yearly loan eligibility is determined by combining your charges and your living expenses (detailed below). This represents the maximum you can borrow. Students always have the option to borrow LESS that maximum, and student are encouraged to borrow only the minimum needed

Federal Loan Options

- If you are a US Citizen or Eligible Non-Citizen you may qualify for federal loan funding. You must submit your [FAFSA](#) each year to determine funding eligibility.
 - You must be enrolled at least half time each semester to receive federal loan funding.
 - Students may qualify for a maximum of \$33,000 in Unsubsidized Loan Funding.
- Interest on federal loans begin at disbursement. To view additional information regarding federal loan interest click [here](#).
- Additional federal loan options include the Grad PLUS Loan. This is a credit checked loan. Additional instructions on how to apply will be provided as it gets closer to the start of the term.
- Please note that if you were to receive scholarship funding your loan funding may be reduced or returned.

Living Expenses

Students who are enrolled at least half time each term may borrow additional loan funding to assist in their living expenses.
